The Union County Bar Association is pleased to announce that it has reformed its **Community Outreach Committee**. The Community Outreach Committee will be Chaired by Nancy Crosta Landale, Esq. of Farkas & Donohue, LLC. President Carol A. Jeney, Esq. will serve as the Officer liaison.

The Community Outreach Committee's focus is very specific: it will enlist volunteers from the Union County Bar Association for various events throughout the year sponsored by the Community FoodBank of New Jersey, an organization fighting hunger and poverty by distributing food and grocery products, providing education and training, and implementing new programs to meet the needs of low-income people. Since its incorporation in 1982, the FoodBank has distributed almost 400 million pounds of food and groceries valued at nearly one billion dollars. The Community Outreach Committee is pleased to announce its inaugural event, to be held at the Community FoodBank of New Jersey, 31 Evans Terminal, Hillside, on Saturday, September 25, 2010 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Adults and children ages 12 and over are invited to attend. Our time with the FoodBank on September 25th will start with a short informational session, followed by an explanation of the types of activities in which volunteers can become involved. During your time at the FoodBank you may be involved with sorting, repacking and labeling salvage food product and household goods for distribution to the FoodBank's member charities, and you will learn about the FoodBank's various programs, including its **Supermarket Gleaning Program** (picking up frozen meats, fresh fruits, vegetables and deli items five days a week from most major supermarket chains and specialty stores); **Sixteen Kids Cafes** (providing hot dinners five days a week to 1300

low-income children in after school programs); the **Kids Closet Program** (distributing new donated clothing free to children in need); the **Tools 4 Schools program** (distributing free school supplies in underserved communities); the **Backpack Program** (providing backpacks full of supplemental nutritious foods to children at risk of hunger over the weekend); the **Family Meals Program** (offering nutritious, heat-and-serve meals to low-income parents); and the ever-popular **Take Your Turkey to Work Day**, an organized turkey collection at Thanksgiving time.
